At the beginning of the year, it was one of the biggest news stories: The traditional French fair FIAC is being replaced by Paris+, the new offshoot of Art Basel in Paris. There was a great outcry, but the format seems more innovative and offers younger galleries in particular a suitable platform to present themselves in the middle of the Palais Ephémère. Don't miss the booths by Édouard Montassut, Heidi Gallery, Marfa' Projects, Parliament Gallery, Peres Projects and sans titre.



**Peres Projects, Berlin**

Marc Padeu reproduces touching scenes on his colour-intensive large-format canvases. The Cameroonian artist works on interpersonal relationships, expressions of love and affection, grief and loss. Some of the arrangements are reminiscent of Manet's "Déjeuner sur l'herbe", compositions from a Western art tradition that the painter clearly locates in his home country in West Africa. Paintings worth seeing, which can be seen alongside other works at the Peres Projects stand.
