## “A Past That Is Future Tense” by Kiyon Williams Peres Projects Milan

In “A Past That Is Future Tense,” Kiyon Williams explores the implications of objects tied to power. Looking at gender roles, flags, busts, columns, and colonial histories, the artist makes audiences question the impact of the items that surround them, and how these objects possess an inherent non-neutrality. Particularly, Williams investigates the American empire, with U.S. flags distorted and destroyed alongside recreations of U.S. Capitol statues. “A Past That Is Future Tense” is on view through July 14, 2023 at Peres Projects in Milan.
