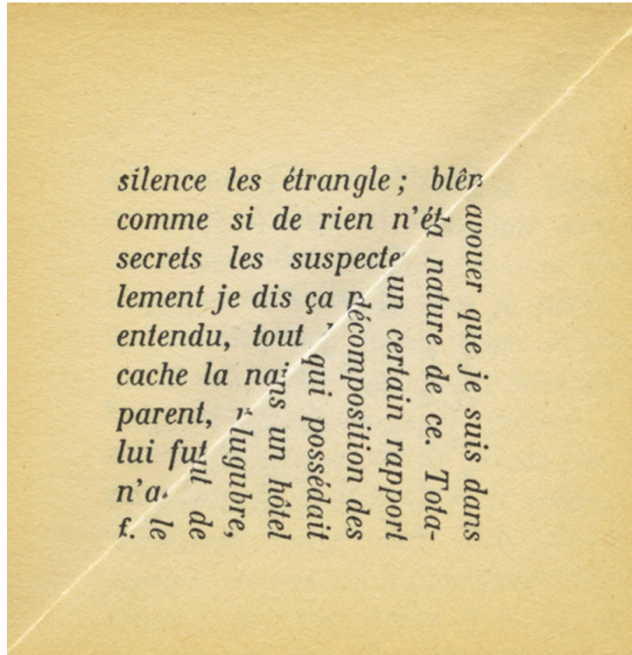


Group exhibition at Galerie Nikolaus Ruzicska, Salzburg

Galerie Nikolaus Ruzicska is hosting a group exhibition featuring five renowned contemporary artists through March 4, 2017.

The show features Francis Baudevin, Erica Baum, Stephane Dafflon, Philippe Decrauzat and Blair Thurman. The show pulls together artists from different generations, who were born in the 1960s and 70s. Each of the works put on display have a shared associating sense, which is distant from uncomplicated to perceive. The initial point of the exhibition is the hanging plan, which is graphic with being talismanic, in a gyratory form proffering a play of permutations, a measure that can be observed appropriately and notionally in all the artists in the exhibit.
