Sprüth Magers Los Angeles presents the exhibition "Nothing Happened" featuring work of artists David Ostrowski, Michail Pirgelis, on view till December 23, 2016.

Michail Pirgelis and David Ostrowski strive to explore the "zero point" of art while completely aware of the futility. They seem to ask what would happen if nothing had happened, and raise the question of whether it would be possible to start over from scratch. The exhibition's title "Nothing Happened," could also be read from a different angle: not in the sense that nothing has happened, but in the sense that the "nothing" happened here, that what happened is the "nothing." Both artists try to open themselves to the unforeseen, to the possibility of contingency and the aesthetic experience of nothingness.
