

Emotional Paintings. David Ostrowski

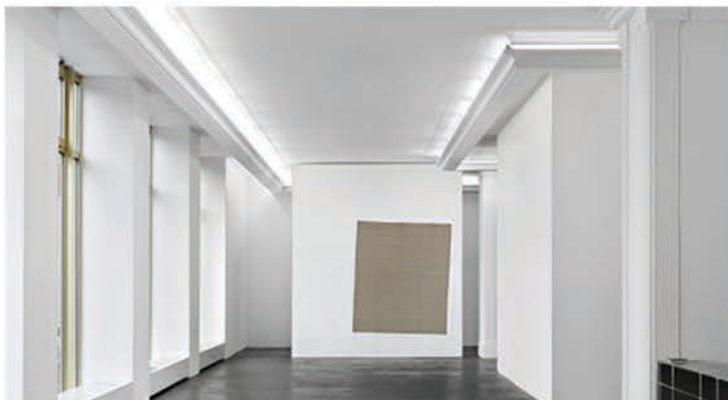


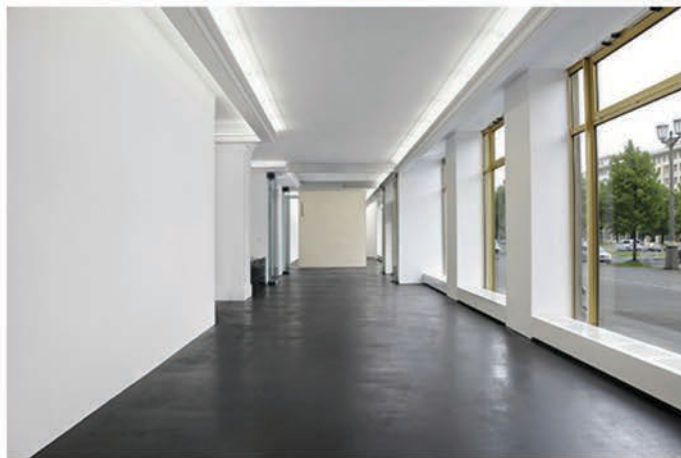
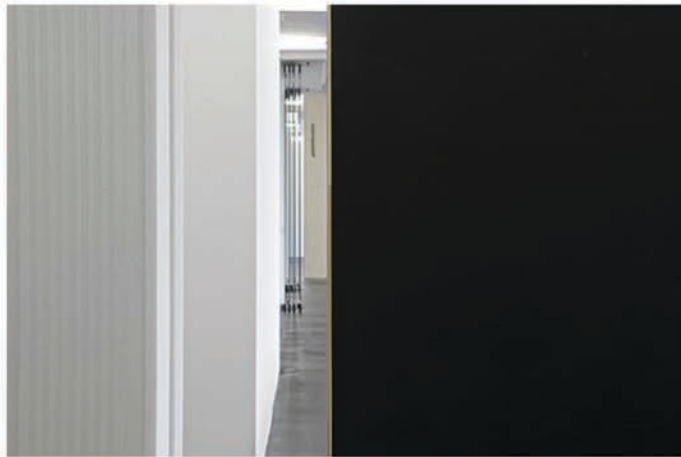
For his second solo exhibition at Peres Projects, Berlin – titled *Emotional Paintings* – David Ostrowski presents a new body of works from the ongoing *F* series. The large paintings on show – made of lacquer, acrylic, linen and cotton on canvas – are minimal and empty; their surfaces bear the traces of gestures like an indefinite line of spray paint or the footprint of one of the artist’s muses. In his pieces Ostrowski also draws inspiration from pop culture phenomena, such as the American TV sitcom “Seinfeld” and the Internet comedy series “Between Two Ferns”. Among the exhibited works are *F (Musik ist Scheisse)*, *F (dann lieber nein)*, *F (I want to die forever)* and *F (The best part of the story)*, all realized in 2014.

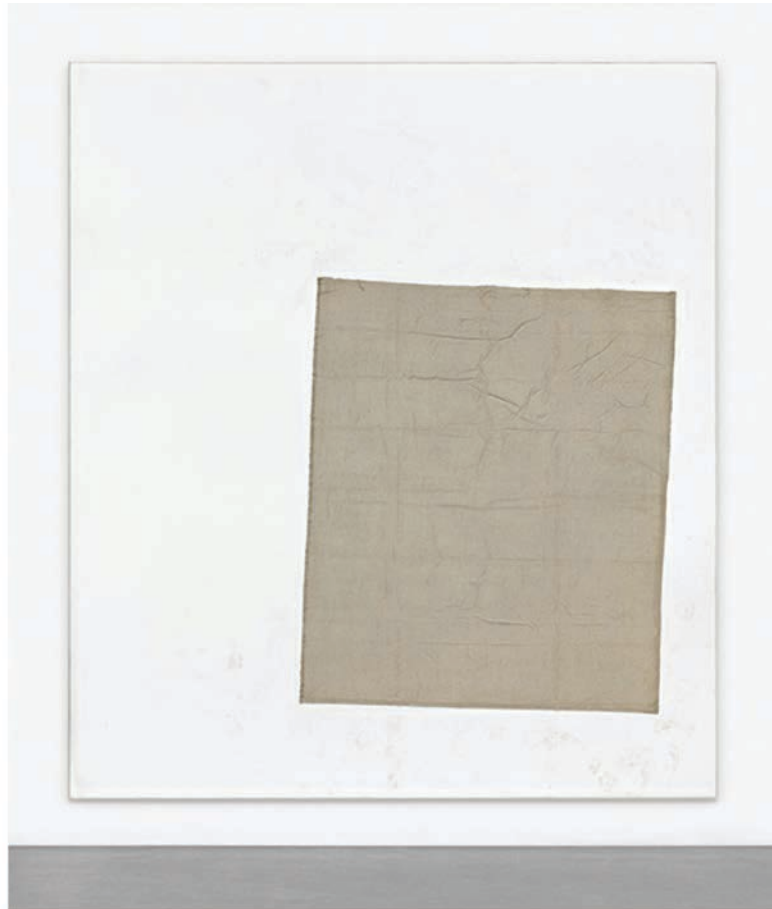
