At Peace at Gillian Jason Gallery

A gallery dedicated to celebrating female and non-binary artists, Gillian Jason is playing host to an unmissable new exhibition right now. Curated by British curator and creative producer of Jamaican heritage Jade Foster, a CCCADI Curatorial Fellow in Afro-Caribbean Art, At Peace showcases the work of five Black eminent female artists: Alanis Forde, Miranda Forrester, Sahara Longe, Cece Philips and Emma Prempeh. Based across the world, from London to Barbados, these contemporary talents are unified by the common themes of identity and subversion in their work, exploring and challenging how Black women have been represented within Western artistic tradition.
